#10 - Plants for the Birds

Plants can attract birds in different ways, and having a yard full of diverse varieties will help you achieve more bird sightings, as well as provide the birds themselves with shelter and food.

#9 - Cleaning Brush

#6 - Squirrel Baffle

Some folks love attracting squirrels to their gardens, others find them to be a nuisance. A squirrel baffle is a great, safe way to deter those pesky nibblers from stealing all of your bird seed right from the feeder. We carry both pole baffles and hanging or tree baffles for wherever you are hanging your feeders.



#5 - Hopper Feeder

This type of feeder not only holds a large amounts of bird seed, but generally attracts larger varieties of birds as well. You can get them in a variety of styles, as well as squirrel-resistant types.

#4 - Bird Baths

Although feeding birds is an essential, water sources for both drinking and cleaning are also very important. Small, bubbling fountains, as well as stagnant bird baths, are great options. We carry bird baths in glass, ceramic, and concrete as well as a variety of fountain styles that can attract these flying friends.

#3 - Bird Houses

Bird houses are not only for nesting, but also as a shelter from storms and an aesthetic addition to your garden. Getting birds to stay or even find your houses, can be challenging, but try different locations and make sure they are protected but easy to find.
